Packed venues, a full calendar and good money. This was reality for Anders Krogh during the three years he was the lead-singer in Robbie Williams Jam. As time passed, however, the joy turned into ambivalence. The kick of being succesfull mixed with a hollow feeling. It was another mans songs, and it was the same show every night.

In the end it became too much, and Anders Krogh quit the band – and the economic safety that came with it. Maybe it tightened up the budget, but it also gave much better room for the songs that had grown in him – the songs that the 34-year old singer and songwriter now lets loose on the soloalbum Trustfundbaby. With own lyrics and own music.

Anders Krogh offers melodic poprock with clear singer-songwriter-qualities, which also bears proof of the co-operation with producer and drummer Johan Lei Gellett, who has worked with, and produced for Kira And The Kindred Spirits. This co-operation, along with the use of vintage-instruments and old studio equipment, has contributed to the albums rich and warm sound.

Lyrics-wise Anders Krogh revolves around his generation, who has always been told that the possibilities were endless, and that youth is something which doesn't necessarily stop at 30. And Anders Kroghs lines about the long youth is written before the scholars came up with the term "child-grown-up" for the group of men in youthful baggy pants and hooded shirts.

Anders Kroghs songs are by far cronics in verse, but are songs for anyone with a hunger for music. The first single "Love You Madly" went directly in hot rotation in Danish P4-radio this fall, and now Anders is ready to follow the success with an entire album – the two tracks "Last Call" and "Shipwreck Survivors" are already in rotation on the nation-wide radio-stations. The singer has alot of qualities – something that has already been noticed outside Denmark. Through his MySpace-profile, he has been offered soundtracks, and an American label has shown interest in a co-operation. Yes, Anders Krogh is well on his way. Solo. And Trustfundbaby is a more than promising start.
