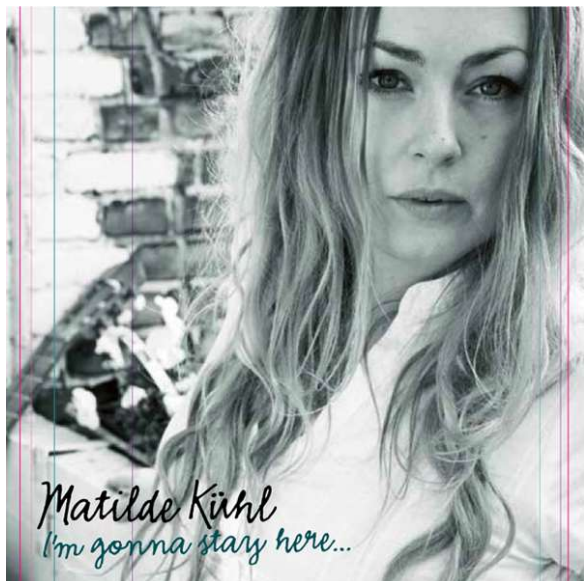


Matilde Kühl – "I'm Gonna Stay Here"

Matilde was raised in a musical family, where her father played world-music in a travelling circus, while Matilde tumbled around in the ring. Ever since then, music has been a returning motive power in her life, and where she finds peace absorption

The international, creative and musical upbringing shines through on Matildes debut-album. With her deep and poetic lyrics you are invited into Matildes universe of music – where she juggles with the great feelings, that meet in life for better and worse.

Matilde sings about everyday-life, and the songs are about everything from burning cars in the streets of Copenhagen to stories about people who trample on you – but they are also about the happy and positive sides of life. Often, however, the melancholic songs and love especially, intrude: "For me, love is a mess of notes that you try and interplay – the older you get, the harder love seems to get. It is not always as black and white as we'd like to make it – which can be both wonderfull and frustrating", Matilde says with a smile. '

Qualified musicians

On the album, Matilde is accompanied by a number of promising young names from the Danish music-scene – and besides from her regular band, the album features guest- appearances by a.o. Matildes own sister Maja Kühl.

The 13 tracks on the album have come to life through an intense musical and personal relationship to pianist and composer Lars Winther, who has also produced and arranged the debut. A cooperation which started in 2004 and which has been a long journey before the album is now finally finished.
