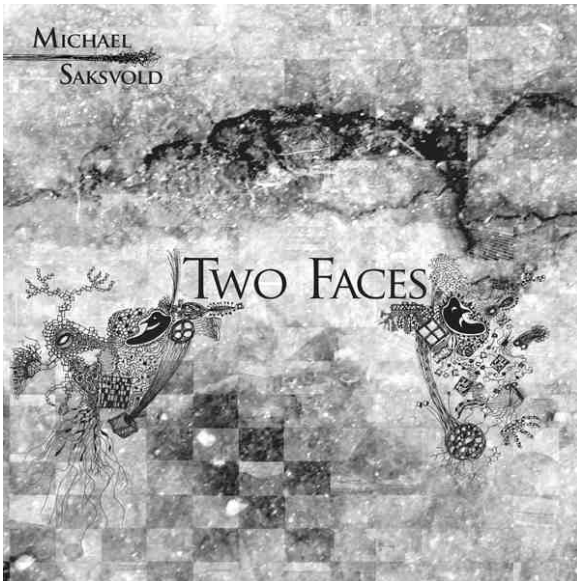


Michael Saksvold – "Two Faces"

Michael Saksvold has been writing music and playing backing for other artists most of his life. Now, the 31-year old guitarist and singer is finally ready with his solo-debut – a no-nonsense rock-album about the tough love.

The dream of a soloalbum became a reality when producer Michael Lyhne from Neverland Studios heard some of Michaels demos on the music-site mymusic.dk. Lyhne contacted Saksvold, and a co-operaiton was made – they went into the studio with Saksvolds band back in 2006.

The songwriting takes its starting-point in Saksvolds own life , a reflection on an emotionally turbulent time for love – and the sound is as rough and unpolished as the feelings it encapsules. Inspired from artists such as Chris Cornell, Bono and danish Claus Hempler, Michael's lightly melancholic, secure and stilistic vocals leads the thoughts towards the american rock-tradition.

Since the early teenage-years, Michael has been an active musiciansn in numerous Danish acts. Even though the future looked bright and the career was progressing, Michael choose the safe road and went for a everyday-life as school-teacher. But the music never left him, and Michael combines life as a teacher with «a rock'n roll way of life».
