*In 2010 Sidsel Marie releases her debut-album "Celebrating an Imperfect Life" – a musical debut that breaks with the polished, with perfectionism and with unattainable ideals and glossy images.*

"Celebrating an Imperfect Life" is a rough mixture of country, garage and folk-rock and the tunes deal with both the complicated love-dramas of daily life, with selfcontrolled businesswomen trying to make a career and with the ideal of the modern woman.

The songs are written by Sidsel Marie herself. Her mission is to remind the listener of the value in the simple, the true and the honest – while keeping an eye for the crooked:

"Give me the sound of a rattling and untuned guitar and a rough vocal without too many unnessecary phrasings, which distorts the picture. I like when the music is raw and slim in it's expression. Maybe I've always been a bit preoccupied with the crooked and different – maybe I've always been a bit strange."

Sidsel Marie is also known as the female counterpart of Tom Morris (former The Pockets) in the desert-rock band Kandy Kolored Tangerine, who has played nomerous big festlvals and showcases in Denmark over the past years. Furthermore she has been touring with Rasmus Lyberth for many years.

"Celebrating an Imperfect Life" is recorded in Stahlbäcks recording studios in Stockholm in co-operation with producer and drummer Andreas Dahlbäck who has previously worked with a.o. Anna Ternheim and Ebba Forsberg.
